

ESN Lille association

Erasmus Student Network Lille (ESN Lille) has been created on the 23rd October 2011 and is a non-lucrative association which counts about 60 volunteers. ESN Lille has several missions, the main one is welcoming and taking care of the international students who come to study in Lille metropolis and the other one is integrating them during their semester or year abroad in the local daily life with different types of events and activities (parties, museum visits, sports events...). The association is also in charge of promoting international mobility to different audiences : institutions, local students or young people in mobility/student fairs and forums and with interventions directly in schools. The association is able to develop thanks to its diverse partners like Lille universities, national institutions and private partners. ESN Lille is part of the French network ESN France and the European one ESN International.

Internship missions

The main goal of the internship is to put in place the Make ESN Greener project. With this project, we want to put the environmental protection at the centre of our association, its daily business and actions. The intern will work closely with the association's board and all its active members, public relations and the ESN network. His mission will be to put in place this new philosophy through concrete actions, always directed at international students. - Student in literature, language, arts, humanities, social sciences (non-exhaustive list)
- Good level of English required (both written and oral)
- Being sensitive to the environmental issues is a fairly good advantage
- Being able to use specific softwares like Photoshop, InDesign, Canva or Gimp
- Being able to use video editing softwares
- Qualities required : availability, creativity, adaptability, know how to work in teams and be able to come up with new ideas

Length and location of the internship

The internship will take place from the 6th May 2019 to 28th June 2019 - 37 working days (flexible). The internship isn't paid. The intern's travel expenses can be paid by the association.
